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Located on the University of Nevada, Reno campus, the 2010 THINK Summer Institute (www.DavidsonGifted.org/THINK), from July 10-31, provided 60 gifted and talented students from across the country a full-immersion college experience, as well as an opportunity to earn transferable college credits by taking two of the following courses taught by university faculty members: Human Development - Mind, Brain,

and Learning; Public Health Biology; Computer Science; Statistics; Philosophy; and, Nano and Micro Technology.

"THINK is an exciting experience because the Davidson Institute does a really awesome job structuring this camp. The environment is great and the staff is terrific. It really is a very intense college experience," Colbert, attended THINK for the second year, said.
